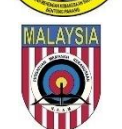

4. Competition program

5. Shooting Qualification round will be organized in AB CD format

6. Qualification Round practice

- 6.1 Form Shooting Target will be available at all time
- 6.2 3 ends warm-up before competition on the Field of Play
- 6.3 Immediate follow scoring once the field is reset

7. Equipment Inspection

- 7.1 Daily at 08.00 hrs. till 08.45 hrs. for archers competing on the day.
- 7.2 To be done on waiting line
- 7.3 Spare equipment must also be brought for inspection
Team Captains are to check the details of their athletes such as name, ID numbers are correct
- 7.3 Inform the Judge if details are not correct and the Judge will Inform result team
- 7.5 Instruction to use the scoring PDA terminals will be carried out if required
- 7.6 Athletes' numbers will be issued on the day of qualification round before warm-up and will be placed on 3m line
- 7.7 Athletes' numbers must be worn on the quiver or thigh, facing the waiting line while shooting

8. Qualification Round and informing on scoring:

8.1. All Recurve division

2 rounds (6 arrows per end 6 ends per round) /122cm face/180sec.

9. Individual Elimination Round

9.1. All Recurve division except U10 (Set system)

1/16 till 1/8 = 2 archers per target, 1/4 till Bronze 1 archer per target / 122cm target face / 90 secs per end of three arrows

10. Gold Medal Matches Alternate Shooting (20 sec per arrow)

11. Appeal Procedure

11.1. An appeal form is attached to this document.

11.2. In case of an intent to Appeal or an actual appeal, the times indicated on the Appeal forms must be considered

12. Results system

12.1. Qualification round – scoring will be done by athletes. One athlete record, on the official paper-based score sheet, the scores of all other athletes on that target. At the same time, another athlete, on that same target, will input all the scores of the athletes on that target into the HHT (Handheld Terminals). All athletes/agent should verify that all scores are written and entered correctly on both score cards paper and HHT

13. Competition Rules

13.1. The Archery competition will be held in accordance with the latest edition of the World Archery (WA) rules that are in force during the conduct of the Games. Version 15 Nov. 2024

13.2. In the case of any disagreement in the rules and regulation, it shall be resolved by Jury of Appeal.

13.3. All athletes and officials participating in this tournament will be issued with only ONE accreditation card (card, plastic cover and lanyard)

13.4. Accreditation card must be worn at all times in the practice and competition areas

14. Logistical Aspects

- 14.1.** Transportation : Venue, Accommodation, Airport etc.

- 14.2.** For oversea participants, transportation will be provided from
official hotels to venue
- 14.3.** Meals own arrangement

15. Protocol and ceremonies

- 15.1.** All medalist to be ready at athletes' holding area 15 minutes before
to be ready for the ceremonies.
- 15.2.** The ceremonies will take place daily upon completion of event.

16. Mixed zone and press conferences

- 16.1.** Interviews will take place at the Mixed Zone and Athletes will be
requested to pass through the mixed zone to speak with the media

17. Medical Related Issues (Medical representatives)

- 17.1.** Medical team and Ambulance services are available on site for any Emergency
- 17.2.** Bentong Hospital is the official hospital

18. Dress Instruction

- 18.1.** Athletes, officials and staff should wear the appropriate clothing and have the correct appearance when on the FOP during competition
- 18.2.** Athletes, team officials and technical crew should wear their uniforms and sports shoes (covering the entire foot) having the same appearance as per division, following WA rules

19. Other matters of importance

- 19.1.** Team Captains, please instruct your team members to use the litter bins provided which are located on the competition, practice ranges and commons areas
- 19.2.** All results and updated documents will be on uploaded on official web-page
- 19.3.** Each one has to respect rules on the FOP and OUT of the FOP during all event.
- 19.4.** In all hotels & home stay it is strictly forbidden to smoke in rooms
- 19.5.** If you don't respect it, we could take penalties of which the cancellation of the participation of your team, what obviously we wish to avoid

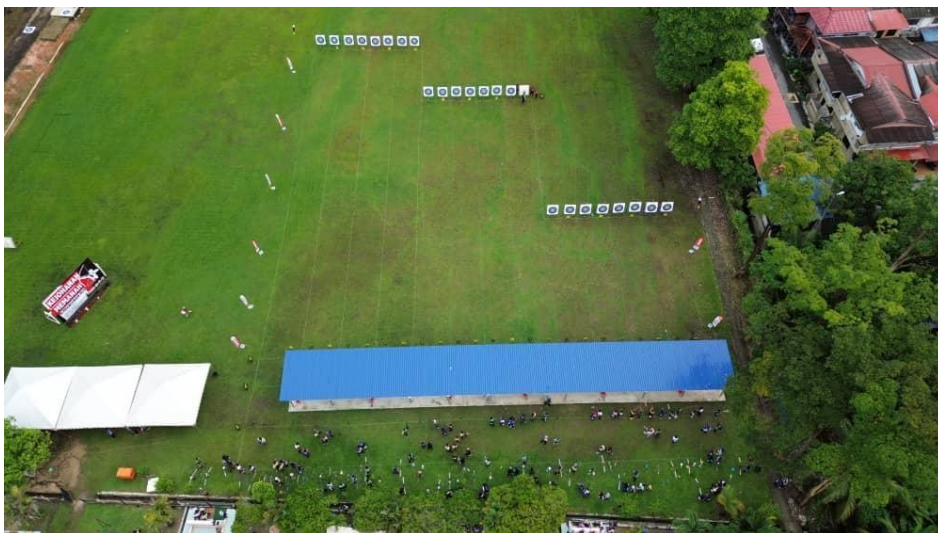
